- 2. The Meeting will be governed by the General regulations of motorsport uk (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these SR's and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. Motorsport uk Permit number:

The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of the following invited clubs: B.T.R.D.A, NPTCC, 750 MC, MTCC, L&NCMC, Camel Vale MC, Bristol MC, holding an RS Clubman Motorsport uk Competition Licence. Club membership cards and competition licences will be inspected at signing on.
- 5. The event is a round of the 2025 motorsport uk Sporting Trial Championship, the 2025 B.T.R.D.A. Sporting Trial Championship, sponsored by Tulleys Farm.
